<u>KACD Auxiliary Report</u> – Ms. Lisa Mullins updated the board on the scholarship recipients and Auxiliary events to be held at the KACD Annual Meeting. The quit is currently being worked on and the theme for next year is going to be wildflowers.

Watershed Rehab Discussion

- KACD worked to receive \$5 million in the last legislative session for watershed rehab funds to be able to leverage federal dollars into the state for rehab. This money will be administered by the Soil and Water Conservation Commission. At this time, we are unsure how the money will be spent.
- The National Watershed Coalition has been invited to the KACD Annual Meeting to speak about the programs they have worked on in other states with rehab projects using state and federal funds.

KACD/NRCS TA Grant Program

- We currently have 30 partner technicians in the field.
- KACD is still looking for 20 additional employees.
- 2 counties are currently going through the process of hiring.

Natural Resources Conservation Service – Mr. Greg Stone updated the board on the tornado relief work
currently going on in Western Kentucky. We have received 7 additional employees from other states to
help with this work. Also, the field work with EQIP is going well. They have allocated their original \$18
million and have been approved for an additional \$900,000.

Ms. Sonya Keith gave an update on talking to all the watershed sponsors in Kentucky.

- **KY Division of Conservation** Ms. Paulette Akers update the board on the State Envirothon Competition that was going on during the meeting. Some of the rules of the program were discussed and will be reviewed and updated before the contest next year. She also announced the Area 1 Soil and Water Conservation Commissioner is Mr. Don Overby from Calloway County.
- Department for Natural Resources –
- Farm Service Agency Mr. Dean Schamore updated the board on the following:
 - Their offices are working on the Emergency Relief Program currently with the western KY tornados.
 - o All FSA offices are currently open and currently accepting producer planning reports.
 - Loans are being offered at good rates at this time.

- **KY Division of Forestry** Ms. Pam Snyder updated the board on the following:
 - Currently they are working on which conservation district will be awarded the forestry award at the KACD Annual Meeting.
 - The tree seedling program will be done though online orders this year.
